

BILLING OUTLINE

This outline sets out the BILLING alias TRELAWDER family connections in Cornwall over two hundred years. It is unusual to see an alias - our modern equivalent being the hyphenated name - being sustained over so long a time.

THE HERALD'S VISITATION OF 1620 FOCUSED SOLELY ON THE LINE OF JOHN BILLING / TRELAWDER'S FIRST SON JOHN WHO MARRIED MARGERY BLEWET AND SETTLED AT ST TUDY IN THE 1640S.

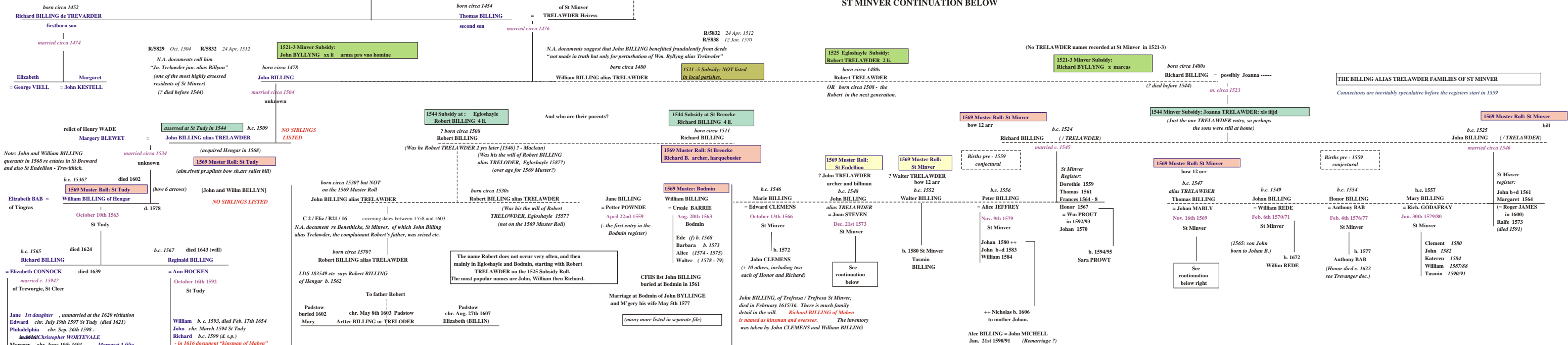

There are BILLING alias TRELAWDER families in Bodmin, Egloshayle & St Breock, and Padstow & St Merryn that must be descended from the families shown here. Some of these are detailed separately; but no attempt has been made to link them.

John BILLING, of Trefusa / Trefusa St Minver, died in February 1615/16. There is much family detail in the will. Richard BILLING of Mabon is named as kinsman and overseer.

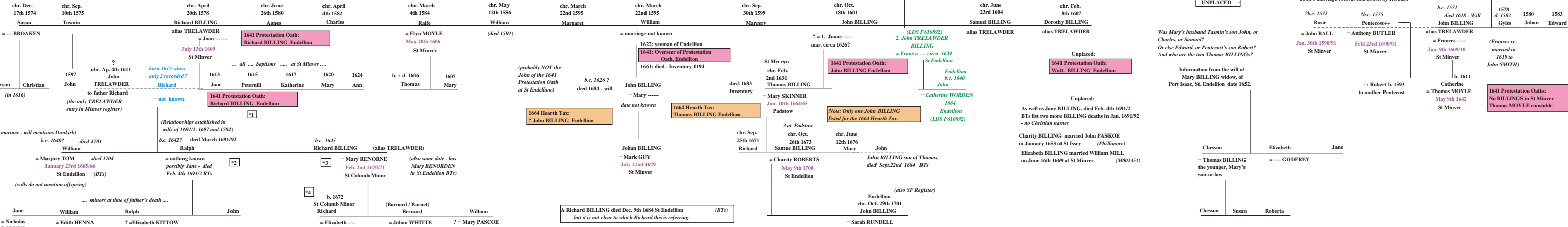

When Richard BILLING died in 1624 his estates included parts of TRELAWDER in St Minver which he had inherited. Note: Loveday HAMBLY is L.V. Hodgkin's "Quaker Saint"
