This outline attempts to interpret the known facts, as presented in the various parish registers, but there are too many gaps in the registers to make any firm judgements. The second half of the 17th century for example is very poorly covered in Maltby.

On the other hand, although the name is not common in the 1379 Subsidy Rolls we do find a Willelmus BOCHER assessed at Maltby for iiiij.d, and at nearby Wadworth a Stephanus BOCHER.

At nearby Ravenfield we have the interesting entry:
Hugo Bacon: bocher - where this is clearly the trade, in line with a number of claims that the word derives from the French 'boucher'

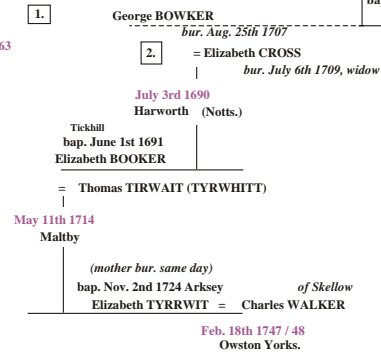
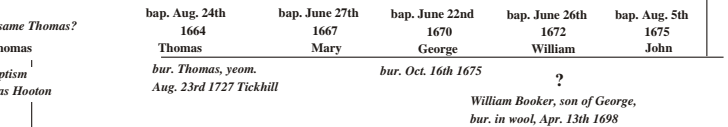
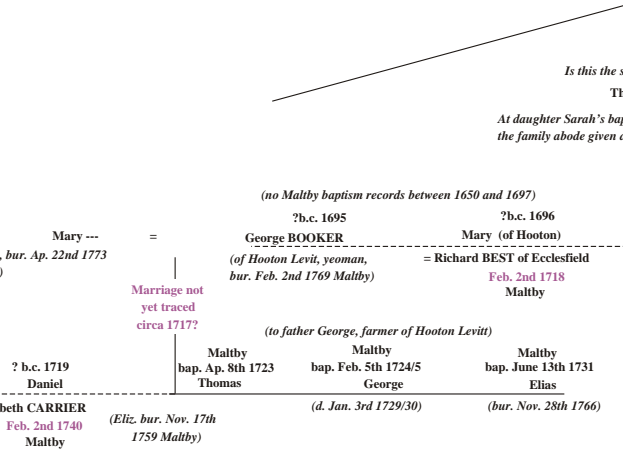
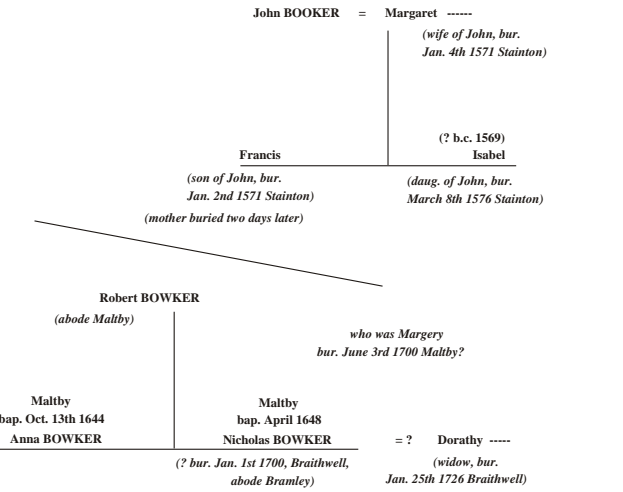
A John BOULKER of Braythwell was buried on April 10th 1605

Around this time at Braithwell there were 3 families with children being born - the summary shown here is incomplete

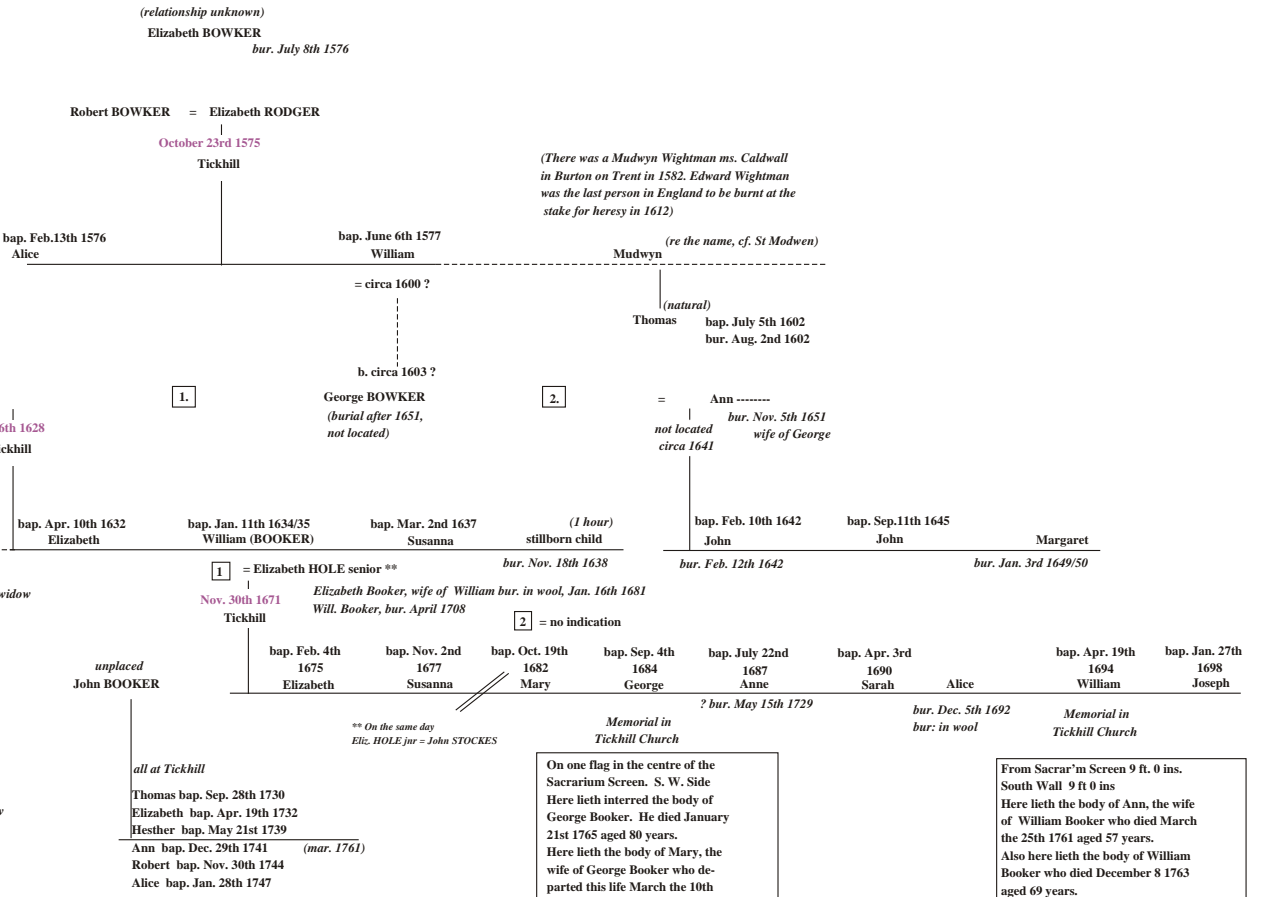
James BOULKER <i>(his son James bur. 1616, daughter Isabel bur. 1617 James himself bur. March 25th 1619)</i>	John BOULKER = Alice ----- <i>(John bur. Ap. 29th 1628 Alice bur. May 3rd 1623)</i> Daughter, Penelope b. 1602/3 married 1631/2	Francis BOULKER = Anne ----- <i>(Francis bur. Apr. 26th 1628 Anne bur. March 29th 1624)</i> (2 infants died in 1604 -5) Grace, b.1601/2 married in 1624

Dorothie, Anne, Anne, Jennette and Elysabeth all married between 1616 and 1629

Also unplaced: Elizabetha BOOKER buried Feb. 26th 1640 at Loversall.

On one flag in the centre of the Sacrarium Screen. S. W. Side Here lieth interred the body of George Booker. He died January 21st 1765 aged 80 years. Here lieth the body of Mary, the wife of George Booker who departed this life March the 10th 1766 aged 78 years.

Recorded at the back of burial register A56 /1/ A3 prior to them being covered by new seats and flooring. Another 6 inscriptions refer to later members of the family.
