

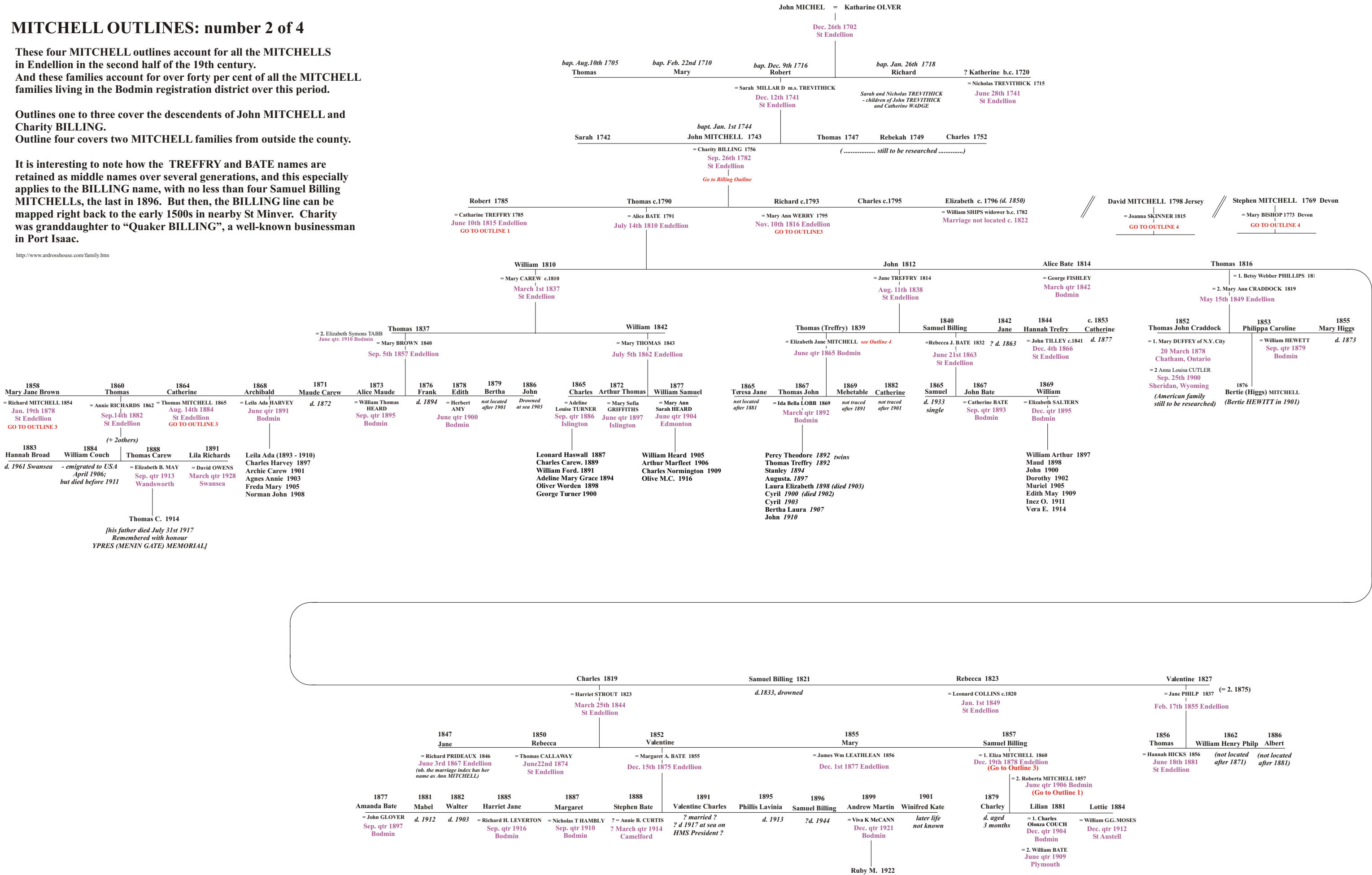
MITCHELL OUTLINES: number 2 of 4

These four MITCHELL outlines account for all the MITCHELLS in Endellion in the second half of the 19th century. And these families account for over forty per cent of all the MITCHELL families living in the Bodmin registration district over this period.

Outlines one to three cover the descendents of John MITCHELL and Charity BILLING. Outline four covers two MITCHELL families from outside the county.

It is interesting to note how the TREFFRY and BATE names are retained as middle names over several generations, and this especially applies to the BILLING name, with no less than four Samuel Billing MITCHELLS, the last in 1896. But then, the BILLING line can be mapped right back to the early 1500s in nearby St Minver. Charity was granddaughter to "Quaker BILLING", a well-known businessman in Port Isaac.
